PURPOSE OF WORKSHOP

In April 2024, the City of Adelaide engaged Stantec to conduct a review of the operational and design parameters of traffic signals within the City of Adelaide. The scope of the project identified that the review:

'shall recommend practical and specific policy positions for the organisation to consider adopting. The review will focus on improving efficiency, safety, and consistency of operational and design parameters.'

This work includes consideration of options to facilitate safer and quicker walking journeys including the implementation of Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (PAC) automation and longer pedestrian crossing signal durations at key areas, and the implementation of touchless and on-demand pedestrian crossing technologies that was requested at the Council meeting in January 2023.

The purpose of the workshop is to provide Council with an update on Stantec's preliminary findings and seek Council Members' views on the findings and options to facilitate safer and quicker journeys.
