EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on activities planned and supported by the City of Adelaide during National Reconciliation Week (NRW) and NAIDOC Week in 2025.

In 2025, the City of Adelaide (CoA) has a stronger focus on activities during Reconciliation Week aligned with the Stretch Reconciliation Action Plan 2024-2027 (RAP) commitments to build an inclusive and equitable community. Initiatives in NRW taking place between Tuesday 27 May and Saturday 3 June include:

- 26 May NRW Artwork Showcase at Adelaide Central Market
- 27 May Reconciliation SA Breakfast

Initiatives during NAIDOC Week taking place between Sunday 6 July and Sunday 13 July include:

- 8 July NAIDOC in the Mall event including performances, storytelling sessions, and interactive activities.
- 9 July The Lord Mayor's NAIDOC Award.
- NAIDOC Artwork Display in the Mall throughout NAIDOC week.

Both weeks will feature displays of the respective themes "Bridging Now to Next" and "The Next Generation: Strength, Vision and Legacy" with flags and banners in key public spaces and social media to drive awareness and participation across multiple platforms.

DISCUSSION

- 1. The City of Adelaide (CoA) remains committed to supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities through its ongoing initiatives and activities during National Reconciliation Week (NRW) and NAIDOC Week.
- 2. The purpose of this report is to provide an update on activities planned and supported by the City of Adelaide during National Reconciliation Week (NRW) and NAIDOC Week in 2025.

National Reconciliation Week, 27 May to 3 June 2025

- 3. The NRW 2025 theme, *Bridging Now to Next*, reflects the ongoing connection between the past, present, and future. It urges us to look ahead and continue moving forward as past lessons guide us.
- 4. Action 2.6 of the CoA's RAP commits to organising at least one NRW event each year at the Adelaide Central Market or/and Rundle Mall.
- 5. A summary of events and activities follows and is summarised in the table below:
 - 5.1. CoA is engaging a First Nations artist through an Expression of Interest process. The artist will create an artwork based on the theme of NRW and display it at the Adelaide Central Market and digitally on the screens in Rundle Mall.
 - 5.2. An event at the Adelaide Central Market will be open to the public and showcase our commitment to celebrating NRW.
- 6. Other activities that CoA will support during NRW include:
 - 6.1. Attendance at the Reconciliation South Australia Breakfast on Tuesday, 27 May 2025 from 6.45 am 9.00 am, to launch NRW in South Australia. First Nations employees, along with the Reconciliation Committee, Council, and Executive Members, have been invited to attend a table hosted by CoA.
 - 6.2. Flagpole banners will be displayed on King William Street and Gouger Street throughout the week.
 - 6.3. CoA social media posts will share information about Reconciliation Week.
 - 6.4. CoA activities during Reconciliation Week are detailed in the following table:

National NAIDOC Week, 6 July to 13 July 2025

- 7. National NAIDOC Week celebrations are held across Australia in the first week of July each year (Sunday to Sunday), to celebrate and recognise the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
- 8. This year's National NAIDOC Week theme, *The Next Generation: Strength, Vision & Legacy,* celebrates achievements of the past and the bright future ahead.
- 9. To embody the 2025 NAIDOC Week theme, the CoA will embed the theme in the delivery of the activities. This will include:
 - 9.1. In activities, speeches and content creation across the week young people's voices will highlight the vital role and voice of young people. Through storytelling, digital media, and public speaking, we will showcase their achievements, creativity, and connection to Country, ensuring their perspectives are heard and valued.
 - 9.2. Engaging a young and emerging First Nations artist to partner with an established artist to deliver the artwork.
- 10. The CoA's RAP commits to two annual events during NAIDOC week:
 - 10.1. NAIDOC in the Mall is a public event that features various Aboriginal businesses, engaging activities for all ages, light refreshments, and entertainment for the duration of the event.
 - 10.2. The Lord Mayor's NAIDOC Award has been an annual event since 2019. The Award is given each year to a respected member of the Aboriginal community who has made significant contributions to Reconciliation in the City of Adelaide.
- 11. The 2025 Lord Mayor's NAIDOC Award ceremony will be held in the Adelaide Town Hall, resuming the morning tea format. It will be a Civic Event for members of the award recipient's family, Reconciliation Committee members and other stakeholders involved in delivering the City of Adelaide's Reconciliation Action Plan.
- 12. In 2024, this event was held in conjunction with the Premier's NAIDOC Awards and the SA NAIDOC Awards, with activities aligned. Due to the significance of the 50 Year Celebration of National NAIDOC Week being hosted in Adelaide in 2024, the organising committees agreed to combine the Awards with one event being held in the Adelaide Town Hall.
