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Purpose of Workshop

The workshop will provide Kadaltilla with an overview of the proposed Tree Management Policy and the strategic framework guiding the management of trees across the Adelaide Park Lands.

The policy seeks to establish a clear, consistent and transparent approach to tree management, balancing canopy outcomes, tree health and longevity, biodiversity, cultural values, community expectations, public safety and the character of the Park Lands.

The workshop will highlight policy principles, objectives and proposed approach, particularly where tree management decisions may involve competing environmental, cultural, recreational, operational and safety considerations.

Key Questions

- Does the proposed policy provide an appropriate strategic framework for managing trees across the Adelaide Park Lands?
- Do the proposed principles appropriately reflect the environmental, cultural, social and recreational values of the Park Lands?
- Are there any areas where Kadaltilla considers greater clarity, guidance or governance is required?

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
